Rental Information and Policy

Thank you for your interest in renting the facilities at Rundle's Mission.
Please read the information below. If you have any further questions do not hesitate to contact our staff by phone: (780) 389-2422 or e-mail: rent@rundlesmission.org

Arrangements for your stay:

Reservations: will be held for **7 days** after your initial booking by phone, fax, or e-mail.
A **deposit of 50%** is required to confirm your booking.
If payment is not received by this time your reservation may be cancelled.

Confirmation Notice will be sent via e-mail or fax upon receipt of your deposit
The balance of payment is due **upon departure**.

Cancellations within **90 days** prior to your booking will forfeit the 50% deposit.
Alterations and cancellations made prior to 90 days before will be charged a 10% Admin Fee of your **total** booking
All alterations and cancellations need to be submitted in writing.

Check-in Time is 5:00 p.m. and Check Out is 2:00 p.m.

In order to give our site staff ample time to prepare the buildings for your stay we ask that you arrive after 5PM and leave before 2 PM. Please arrange your **exact** time of arrival **the week before** your arrival by calling the office at (780) 389-2422. If you require a longer stay we do have hourly rental rates. (Please refer to our Fee Schedule).

The Facilities at Rundle's Mission:

Memorial Lodge is a two-story log facility. The main floor kitchen has 2 gas ranges, two refrigerators, a microwave, freezer and cooking utensils and dishes for 60 people. There are a total of 25 beds in the Lodge (8 downstairs and 17 upstairs). The sleeping quarters have bunk beds in a dormitory setting with washroom facilities downstairs only. The men's washroom is wheelchair accessible. The two stone fireplaces and large meeting and dining areas are perfect for large group activities. The upstairs deck overlooks beautiful Pigeon Lake. Please bring own towels and bedding or book our Linen Service (\$10.00 per person). See www.rundlesmission.org for photos and further details.

The Houses (2) are only steps from the Lodge. Each house is a one storey bungalow with a fully equipped kitchen, with stove, refrigerator, microwave and dishware. The center of the house has a combined dining and living room. Each room (5) has two twin beds with private bath facilities. Please bring your own bedding and towels or book our Linen Service (\$10.00 per person). Each house sleeps 11 guests. Parking available at the back of each house

Camping:

Camping is permitted behind the houses and in parking area by the Lodge. There are no RV's/Trailers allowed on the grassy areas due to our septic system being located in these areas. Camping is limited to 10 camp vehicles (incl. tent trailers, 5th wheels, etc.) + any number of tents. A limited number of electrical hook-ups are available. Consult the hostess for location.

Firewood:

Outside the lodge and houses are two fire pits and a number of picnic tables for the use of renters. Firewood can be pre-booked for \$7.00 per bundle.

Telephone:

There is a telephone in the entryway to the lodge for use by all site users. There are no telephones in the houses. All long distance calls need to be made at the expense of the user. **Internet** access is available by contacting (780) 352-7521 Telus or high speed if you have a router. We suggest you bring a cell phone for emergency contacts.



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Catering:

You may do all your own cooking on site or catering may be arranged with ample prior notice. Please contact the booking office for local catering contacts and references.

AV Equipment:

There is a small TV, VCR, DVD player on site as well as two flip charts in the Lodge. Please ask our hostess for their location.

Sharing Rundle's Mission:

The north-south driveway into Rundle's Mission leads to the Fisherton Cemetery. Parking along this driveway needs to remain available at all times in case of a funeral during your stay.

The Rundle's Mission site includes the Benjamin and Margaret Sinclair Provincial Historic site and interpretive boardwalk. This educational trail is maintained for public use. Please be aware that visitors may use the trails during your stay.

Adjacent to the Rundles Mission is a Nature Reserve (220 acres) with 6 kms of hiking and skiing trails. You may enjoy this beautiful setting but please respect the flora and fauna and take all your garbage with you.

A few additional rules ensure that the site is occupied and maintained with consideration for present and future users:

- Posted fire regulations are to be adhered to at all times. Penalties apply.
- No smoking in any buildings
- No Fireworks allowed – This is a County of Leduc By-Law which will be enforced.
- No motorized vehicles of any kind beyond the driveways and parking areas (including-ski-doo's, ATV's)
- Open fires are restricted to the fire pits. Please keep your fires moderate and be aware of local fire bans
- Substance abuse or disruptive behavior can result in immediate eviction.
- Pets are to be on a leash at all times. Please clean up after them.
- The use of large equipment (hot tubs, outdoor sound systems etc.) brought to the site requires prior approval of the management.
- The management holds the right to enter the premises at any time.

Please sign the attached waiver as part of your rental agreement.

Cleaning the Facilities:

Please leave the site and buildings as you found them. Replace all items used to their original location, tie up garbage in the bags provided and place in the bin north of House #1. Cleaning supplies are provided for your use. Help us keep our cleaning costs to a minimum so we can pass the savings on to you! Please report any damages on your evaluation form.
